Neil works at the Pennington Biomedical Research Center in Baton Rouge, Louisiana and has been involved with several NIH and internally funded clinical exercise intervention trials. These studies include the health benefits of aerobic and resistance training in Type 2 diabetes study (HART-D) investigating the effects of exercise modality on chronic glucose control. Neil is also dedicated to the Fit for Life study which is a multi-center trial investigating the effects of aerobic or regionally specific resistance training in older adults on chronic disease.
